



The Trialogue is a model of leadership activity:

Developed as part of doctoral research by Dudley in 1999 to address the complexity of the management task. The trialogue is consistent with VSMethod and aims to ensure focus on the elements of 'what now', 'why' and 'what next' – issues that are often lost in early stage development.

Derivations of the model are in use in the UK and US across the management and leadership development sector.

A later model (suggested by Lafley, HBR, May 2009) identifies similar relationships and activities but is limited by its inherently hierarchical nature – thereby losing the benefit of scalability.
